

# **KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA RAILWAY COLONY- BANGALORE – 23**

## **MINUTES OF THE VIDYALAYA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE** **HELD ON 05<sup>th</sup> AUGUST 2009**

The Vidyalaya Management Committee meeting was held on 05<sup>th</sup> August , 2009. The meeting began with the Principal welcoming the Chairman Shri Akhil Agrawal and members of the Committee and requesting the Chairman to preside over the meeting. The 19- point agenda, a copy of which is enclosed was discussed at length.

1. The Principal apprised the committee about the CBSE results of classes X & XII in the year 2009. The school achieved 100% result in classes X & 94.4% in class XII Board Examinations held in March 2009.
2. The teachers who had produced 100% results in their respective subjects in classes X and XII CBSE Exam were honoured by the Committee and the Chairman Felicitated them with mementos.
3. Reviewing Academics :

The Principal apprised the Committee about the results and the Committee was in full praise over this achievement of the School. The reason for the setback in Mathematics was deliberated and measures to obtain 100% result during the Board Exam in the year 2010 was discussed. The Committee advised to aim at achieving 100% result in the coming year in both the classes and try to be the best school in KVS Bangalore Region. An assurance was given by the Principal to achieve the target already set for the teachers in this connection at a special meeting that had already been held with these teachers. The Principal further informed the Committee that every month tests are being held ; parents are being apprised about their wards and remedial teaching for weak students are going on .Queries were asked regarding the information on how many students scored overall 75% and 60% .All the information was clearly furnished. It was felt that despite doing so well wide publicity was not given to the school results in the print media unlike some private schools .It was agreed to give wide publicity to the results in the coming year.

Internal Exam results classes I to IX and XI which was discussed and suggestions were given to improve the quality of results with more interaction with parents. The Principal reiterated the commitment of the staff to improve the results both qualitatively and quantitatively in the coming session.

4. The Committee gave its approval for the construction of six additional classrooms as per KVS letter No. F110114/87/2008-KVSHQ(W) dated 22-06-09 to convert the existing building into a full fledged A type (two section) building ,after preparing the estimate and submitting it to KVS for approval ,and sanction of fund for the construction.
5. The Committee gave its approval to construct a ramp near the entrance main gate and also to convert a toilet for differently abled students as per KVS directions. The Committee wanted to know how many such children were there. It was informed that there was one student who is unable to even walk in class VII.The Committee suggested trying to enable him to use a wheelchair. The Committee also suggested providing a handle on the wall in the Western style toilet provided for such children. The Principal assured to adhere to the suggestions.
6. The Committee approved of the suggestion of construction of one step along the entire length of the corridor adjacent to the ground with the help of the railway authorities.

7. The Principal informed the Committee that a children's park with fencing has already been completed from MP's fund in the Vidyalaya campus and it is required to install suitable play materials for Primary children  
The Committee gave its approval for the installation of suitable play materials for primary children in the children's park. The Principal informed that an amount of Rs. 1.4 Lakhs was needed to be spent from VVN for the purchase of the Play materials. The Committee gave its approval to go ahead with the purchase.
8. The Committee was apprised of the condition of some of the old furniture that had become unfit for use and it had become necessary to condemn them and procure new furniture for the Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary classes during the academic year 2009-2010. Five Steel Almirahs also needed to be purchased. An approval for the utilisation of Rupees Two Lakhs from the VVN was sought. The approval was given by the Committee.
9. The Committee approved of arranging excursions and study tours for all the classes to the nearby places.
10. The Committee gave its approval for the beautification of the Vidyalaya garden with seasonal and ornamental plants and the purchase of lawn grass as per the requirement, for which the expenditure is to be met from the VVN funds.
11. The Committee was informed that it was required to purchase computers in order to further strengthen the computer education in the Vidyalaya .Therefore another 5 computers needed to be purchased during the academic year 2009-2010 following the DGS&D rates. This proposal was approved of by the Committee.
12. The Committee also gave its approval to arrange guest lectures to enlighten the students about career guidance. It was suggested to even have experts from fields other than Engineering and Medicine could give Career Guidance with regard to the fact that a wide range of careers are open to them in the other fields for example in Humanities and Commerce Streams too. This idea was enthusiastically responded to by the Committee and Shri Amarnath Dube, DPO SW Railway ; Nominee Chairman of the Vidyalaya happily obliged to present a lecture to the Senior Secondary students on this subject. Another member Smt. Pampa Devi also readily offered to speak on the avenues open in the Humanities stream.
13. The Committee agreed to the proposal to take up the project of Mural painting/wall paintings, which is a continuous process on the inner side of the Vidyalaya, compound walls and other suitable places as a learning experience for students to develop their creative skills. Permission was accorded to meet the expenses.
14. The Committee discussed about the construction of a basket ball court with cement concrete flooring as per the estimates submitted by HSCL, which has already been sent to KVS for approval and sanction of funds. The Committee gave its approval for the same.
15. The committee agreed to look into the proposal to re-floor the Activity-Hall with vitrified tiles by using VVN funds. The Committee suggested preparing estimates and doing the needful as per the requirements. The Committee assured all assistance and gave its approval.
16. The Committee was informed that the proposal of starting the Commerce Stream at +2 level in the Vidyalaya was kept pending since no extra classrooms were available.

17. It was proposed to condemn the old furniture and other unusable materials in the Vidyalaya belonging to the different departments of the Vidyalaya
18. The Committee gave its approval for the preparation of the budget for VVN and School Fund as per KVS norms to be submitted before 14<sup>th</sup> of August to KVS, Regional office, Bangalore.
19. The Committee suggested the utilisation of Railway Grounds for promotion of Sports & Games for the benefit of the students. The Committee also extended its assistance to provide Scout & Guides Masters to further train the student for the movement.
20. The committee approved of holding the meeting thrice a year, as per KVS norms in the first weeks of March, August & December.
21. The Committee was overjoyed to learn that five students had won the NTSE Scholarship and decided to felicitate the students on the 15<sup>th</sup> of August at the Independence day function to be conducted by the Railway authorities.
