MINUTES OF THE VIDYALAYA MANAGAMENT COMMITTEE HELD ON 4th December 2009

The Vidyalaya Management Committee meeting was held on 4th December 2009. The meeting began with the Principal welcoming Shri Akhil Agrawal, IRSSE, DRM cum Chairman, Vidyalaya Management Committee, of this Vidyalaya and the other members of the Committee and requesting the Chairman to preside over the meeting. The 14- point agenda, a copy of which is enclosed was discussed at length.

1. The Principal appraised the Committee about the Mid-Term Examination of classes X and XII. The Committee was appraised about low achievers and high achievers of classes X and XII and reiterated the commitment of the staff to improve results both qualitatively and quantitatively in the coming session.

As regards the *Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation Scheme for class IX from this session 2009-2010 and class X in session 2010-2011* the Committee was appraised about the changes in the new Education Policy formulated by Shri Kapil Sibal, Honourable Minister for Human Resources and the same implemented by the CBSE.

The Principal appraised the Committee about the *BAL DIWAS* and *GRAND-PARENTS' DAY* celebrated by the Primary Section.

The Committee was also appraised about 10 students who participated from our Vidyalaya in the National Sports Meet-2009, held at New Delhi between 14-11-2009 and 20-11-2009 and about FOUR boys winning Gold Medal for Kho-Kho and THREE girls who got Bronze Medal for Kho-Kho.

2. The Committee gave its approval to construct six additional class-rooms as per KVS letter No.F-110114 / 87 / 2008-KVS HQ(W) dated 22/06/2009 to convert the existing building into a full fledged A type (two section) building. The Committee was also informed that the estimate has been approved by KVS Head Quarters and the detailed estimate and line diagram will be submitted to KVS shortly for the sanction of funds.

3. The Committee gave its approval to install suitable play materials for Primary children in the already constructed Children's Park with fencing done from MP's money in the Vidyalaya Campus. It was suggested by the Committee to purchase good-quality steel materials if procuring fibre play materials proved to be expensive. The Committee gave its approval for the utilization of an amount of Rs. 1.4 Lakhs approximately to spend from the VVN for the purchase of Play materials.

4. The Committee approved the suggestion to procure some new furniture for Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary classes during the academic year 2009-2010 as some of the old furniture have become unfit for use. Moreover, five steel Almira's are also needed by the Vidyalaya. The Committee approved the usage of Rupees 2 Lakhs approximately for this purpose.
5. The Committee supported the idea of arranging study tours/excursions for all classes which has already been planned and would be implemented in December/January-2010. It was suggested to have special package designed by IRCTC. The Committee endorsed the view that the students of IX and XI could be taken for a one-day tour. Various places of tourist attraction within the city were suggested.
6. The Principal informed the Committee that the beautification of the Vidyalaya is going on. Some seasonal and ornamental plants and lawn grass need to be purchased as and when required for which the expenditure was to be met from VVN funds. The Committee gave its approval.
7. The Committee was appraised of the need to purchase two 3KVA/5KVA on-line UPS to install in the Computer Lab in order to further strengthen the Computer Education in the Vidyalaya.
8. The Principal conveyed his thanks on behalf of the Vidyalaya and on his own behalf to SWRWWO (South Western Railway Women's Welfare Organization) for arranging Guest Lectures on inspiring and motivating talks including Career Guidance. The Committee agreed to help further and endorsed the proposal to arrange for more guest lecturers to enlighten the students about career guidance.
9. The Committee gave its approval to take up the project of Mural Paintings/Wall Paintings on the inner side of the Vidyalaya, compound walls and other suitable places as a learning experience for students to develop their creative skills. Permission was accorded to meet the expenses from the VVN funds.
10. The Activity Hall and Principal's Chamber required re-flooring with vitrified tiles using VVN funds. Estimate prepared for the Activity Hall by the Railway authorities has already been sent to KVS for approval. The re-flooring of the said rooms was approved of by the Committee.
11. The Committee discussed the condemnation of old furniture and other unusable materials in the Vidyalaya belonging to different departments of the Vidyalaya and approved for the same.
12. The Budget-Estimates for 2009-2010 submitted for KVS was presented for discussion and the Committee approved of the same.
13. The Committee agreed to look into the proposal to allot some land adjacent to the Vidyalaya for the expansion of the Vidyalaya and to develop a play-ground to promote a few games for the benefit of the students. The DRM offered the Railway Grounds for the Sports and Games events of the Vidyalaya.
