

KENDRIYA VIDYALAYA RAILWAY COLONY- BANGALORE – 23

MINUTES OF THE VIDYALAYA MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

The meeting began with the Principal welcoming the Chairman and other members of the Committee and requesting the Chairman to preside over the meeting. The 17- point agenda, a copy of which is enclosed was discussed at length.

1. a) The Principal apprised the committee about the CBSE results of classes X & XII. The school achieved 100% results both in classes X & XII Board Examinations.
b) Suggestions were invited from the members for academic improvement. The Principal reiterated the commitment of the staff to improve the results both quantitatively and qualitatively in the coming session.
2. The Committee gave its approval to arrange for guest lectures to enlighten the students about career guidance.
3. The Committee gave its approval to purchase another 05 computers for the academic year 2008-09 following the DGS&D rates, in order to further strengthen the computer education in the Vidyalaya.
4. The committee discussed the procurement of furniture to meet the growing need created by the new admission policy resulting in increase in the class size. The Committee agreed to the proposal put up by the Principal for procurement of suitable furniture for the primary, secondary and senior secondary classes including suitable chairs for computer labs and activity hall and five cupboards during the academic year 2008-2009.
5. The Committee approved the suggestion to arrange excursions/study tours for all classes.
6. The Principal informed the Committee that a basketball court with cement concrete flooring was proposed to be constructed as per the estimate submitted by the HSCL, which has already been sent to KVS for approval and sanction of funds. The Committee members visited the area meant for the basketball court and gave their approval for the same.
7. The Committee was apprised of the fact that a children's park with fencing was already constructed from MP's fund in the Vidyalaya campus and it was required to install suitable play materials for primary children. The Committee gave its approval for the utilisation of Rs. 1.25 Lakhs to be spent from VVN for the purchasing of Play materials.
8. The Committee approved to take up the project of Mural paintings/wall paintings on the inner side of the Vidyalaya, compound walls and other suitable places as a learning experience for students to develop their creative skills. Permission was also accorded to meet the necessary expenses.
9. The Committee gave its approval to meet the expenditure from VVN funds for beautifying the Vidyalaya Garden with seasonal and ornamental plants, lawn grass and aquarium as per the requirement.
10. Either the removal of the back gate and construction of a permanent concrete wall or to fix a sheet gate to the height of the compound wall in order to ensure the safety of the Vidyalaya was agreed upon and approved of by the Committee.

11. The Committee agreed to look into the proposal to allot some land adjacent to the Vidyalaya for the extension of the Vidyalaya and to develop a playground to promote a few games.
12. The Committee also gave its approval for the construction of another 16 class rooms by demolishing the existing unusable temporary asbestos shed in the Vidyalaya to expand the Vidyalaya from 2 sections to 3 section schools.
13. The Committee agreed to the proposal of the construction of one step along the entire length of the corridor adjacent to the ground.
14. The Committee discussed the condemnation of old furniture and other unusable materials belonging to different departments of the Vidyalaya and approved for the same.
15. It was proposed to modify the Principal's Chamber by construction a glass door with aluminium shutters, bifurcating the room with aluminium/wooden screen; flooring with tiles/ carpet. Permission was given to meet the expenses for the same after estimating the cost from the VVN.
16. The committee agreed for the proposal of reconstitution of the VMC as the term for the present VMC completes by 26-09-2008.
